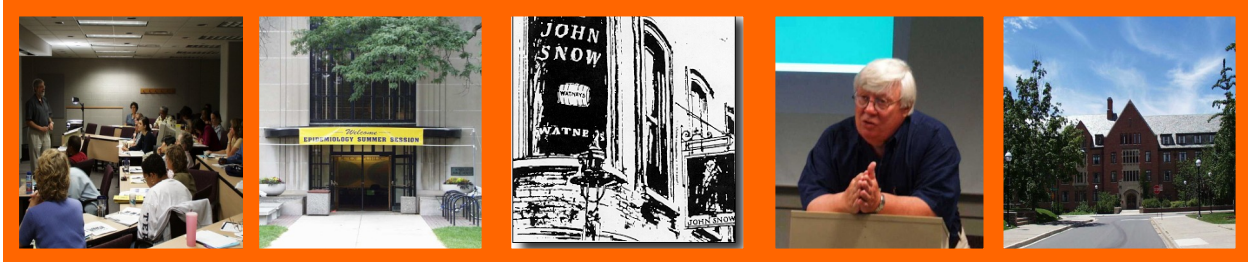
The Practice Scholar will receive full or partial scholarships for application fees and tuition costs for non-credit courses. CME credit fees are not covered by this scholarship program.

Applications must be received by **May 8, 2009**. Applicants will be notified of acceptance into the scholarship program via email. Once accepted, Practice Scholars will be instructed to fill out the Graduate Summer Session application and include notification of scholarship award. Award of funding is contingent upon admission into the Graduate Summer Session program.

Applicants will be limited to one course scholarship until it is determined whether there is sufficient funding to support additional course scholarships.
